Etiquette

Tradition and safety, not fashion, governs correct dress in the hunting field and it is a courtesy to the Hunt and landowners to be well turned out.

Gentlemen should wear a black coat with buff or cream breeches, a plain white stock, a black hat and black boots.

Ladies can wear a black or a navy coat.

Please ensure that your horse is clean, well turned out and plaited if possible, tack must also be clean, safe and not brightly coloured.

Please remember hunting is by kind permission of the farmers and landowners.
